Instructions for Request for Live Scan Service form

- 1. Pick up two copies of the <u>Request for Live Scan Service</u> form from the head of the department for which you are volunteering..
- 2. Before your fingerprint appointment please complete the following sections.
 - **Section** A: Check the box(es) for the type of volunteer service you are currently providing, or for which you plan to provide.
 - *Section B*: Completed for you.
 - **Section C**: Before your appointment, please complete this section, beginning with "Name of Applicant." Include any and all aliases you have ever used, including maiden name, prior married name, etc.
 - **Sections D and E**: Circle whichever applies to your volunteer service, parish or school. If you are volunteering for both the parish and school, please circle parish.
 - Bottom part of Section E: Live Scan operator/technician will complete this section.
 - Signature Section at the bottom of page: Please sign and date this when in the presence of the Live Scan operator/technician.
- 3. Take your two forms and your government issued photo ID with you to your appointment.
- 4. Be certain that you sign both forms at your appointment, and that the Live Scan operator/technician signs both forms.
- 5. The technician will keep one completed form and you will keep one completed form.
- 6. Make a copy of your completed form, and turn it in to the St. Louise department for which you are volunteering.
