

A: Closure of a Dangerous Parking Entrance

Reconfiguration of the parking lot entrance, by broadening the Bonnie Cove Ave entrance and closing the Covina Boulevard entrance between the church and parish center.

B: A Repaved, Redesigned Parking Lot

In constant use by parishioners, the school and ministries, the parking lot is overdue for a complete redesign and repaving.

C: Campus Enclosure

An encompassing set of gates and fences strategically designed to provide a safe environment for our church and school youth.
