# Pentecost Sunday May 23, 2021



There appeared to them tongues as of fire, which parted and came to rest on each one of the them. And they were all filled with the Holy Spirit.

## Pentecost Sunday

Pentecost marks the occasion of God sending the Holy Spirit upon Jesus' disciples after his Resurrection. The book of Acts describes how the disciples were gathered together in one place on the day of Pentecost. The Jewish feast of Pentecost (Shavuot or the Feast of Weeks) was a day that commemorated the giving of the law to Moses, a day soon to be marked as well by the giving of the Holy Spirit. The day of Pentecost was a turning point for the disciples:

*Before Pentecost, the disciples were unsure of what they were to do next and spent most of their time in hiding. After Pentecost and [receiving] the gifts of the Holy Spirit, they understood their mission to spread the Good News of Jesus, and they had the courage to come out of hiding and speak openly about who Jesus was and what he had accomplished by his dying and rising.*

On Pentecost, the Holy Spirit gave the disciples the strength to fulfill their commission to spread the Good News of Jesus. The Church marks this day through a special liturgical celebration:

*The Solemnity of Pentecost, on the fiftieth day of Easter, concludes the Easter season. In recent years, the Church has restored the extended vigil for this solemnity. Similar to Easter, the vigil of Pentecost includes four readings from the Old Testament, each with a proper Psalm and prayer, along with the Epistle and Gospel. At the conclusion of the Mass during the Day, the Paschal Candle is extinguished and moved to its permanent location near the baptismal font.*

The Solemnity of Pentecost, which crowns and fulfills the Easter season, is a good time to pray for a deeper indwelling of the Holy Spirit.

### Prayer to the Holy Spirit

*The following prayer was recited by Pope Benedict XVI in a homily on November 7, 2006. This is a prayer to the Holy Spirit.*

**Let us invoke him  
so that he will irrigate, warm and straighten,  
so that he will pervade us  
with the power of his sacred flame

at this time, in these days.  
Amen**

## PENTECOST

COME, HOLY SPIRIT, COME!

Come, Holy Spirit! Today we celebrate Pentecost, the outpouring of the Holy Spirit upon the first disciples and on all who are baptized. We also commemorate the birth of the Church. Before Pentecost, the disciples remained hidden and uncertain; at Pentecost, those who were gathered were filled with the Spirit and proclaimed the wonders of the Good News of Christ to all. The Spirit guides us to the truth of Christ's love and mercy and strengthens us to live as disciples. Without the Holy Spirit, we would perish; with the Spirit, we have life to the full. Relying on the Spirit, we are given the grace to turn away from the many temptations that we face each day and prefer instead what is good and holy. Come, Holy Spirit, come!

THE FRUIT OF THE SPIRIT

As followers of Jesus, we are called to direct our minds and hearts to Christ's love, turning away from all that is not of God in order to be more Christ-like in our daily lives. The more we invite the Holy Spirit to draw us close to God's heart, the more readily we will avoid sin and choose life, faith, and love. In the letter to the Galatians, we hear a list of things that those who live in the Spirit are to avoid. Things like immorality, hatred, jealousy, and selfishness. At first glance, we might think to ourselves, "of course I want to avoid those things," and yet, if we are honest with ourselves, we likely recognize some of those patterns in our lives. Upon further reflection, however, we also see that these negative behaviors pose temporary pleasure while the fruits of the Spirit—love, joy, peace, patience, kindness, generosity, faithfulness, gentleness, and self-control—lead to a life of deep and lasting fulfillment.

NOTHING WILL STAND IN THE WAY

The Jewish people who had gathered in Jerusalem for the festival of Pentecost came from every corner of the world. They spoke many languages and yet were drawn to hear the message of Christ from the disciples who had just experienced the outpouring of the Holy Spirit. They were astonished by what they heard—not only the message, but the way in which it was conveyed, in their own language, and by the messengers, people whom they would have considered ordinary and unremarkable, rather than the acknowledged religious leaders of their time. We, too, are called to share the love and mercy of Christ through word and action, even when we feel small and insignificant. We need only to look at the witness and experience of those first disciples and all the saints who have preceded us to know that we are capable of much when we place our lives in God's hands. Nothing can stand in the way of the incredible love of God when we are filled with the power and presence of the Holy Spirit!

## THIS WEEK'S HIGHLIGHTS

### Renovation Realities

When the pandemic started some consumer products could not be found anywhere. Hand sanitizer, toilet paper and disinfectant wipes seemed to be more valuable than bitcoin! As the pandemic wore on, other goods were in short supply or required additional lead times to receive once orders were placed. It seems that floor tile for a large job like the church building is one of those commodities.

Initially we hoped to use a limestone tile throughout the nave, but that cost was prohibitive and the lead time to receive the limestone was being measured in months, not weeks, as it would have to be shipped from overseas.

Instead, a more cost-effective porcelain tile was selected. Porcelain also requires less ongoing maintenance than limestone, thus making it a more practical choice. Since this tile is manufactured in Tennessee, delivery would be faster as well.

But 6,200 square feet of tile still requires time to manufacture and deliver. Unfortunately you can't go to the local Home Depot or Lowe's to find that quantity! The order was placed before Easter and an estimated 8 to 10 week delivery time was provided. As of writing this article, the tile is expected to arrive in Ontario, CA on Thursday, May 27th, and delivered to the job site the next day or hopefully no later than Tuesday, June 1st.

In the meantime, floor underlayment prep and stair treads for the altar are being installed. The steps on the altar will be made from limestone and are expected to begin installation next week.

## SAINT MADELEINE SOPHIE BARAT (1779-1865)

May 25th

Born to a cooper and winemaker in Burgundy, France, Madeleine was educated by her older brother, Louis, who was studying for the priesthood. He strove to repress her emotions and instruct her as if she were a seminarian. Her extensive formation, unusual for the time, paid off, as Madeleine was prepared for the rebirth of French Catholicism after its persecution during the French Revolution. In 1800, she and three companions began the Society of the Sacred Heart of Jesus. Madeleine was appointed superior at 23, and over the next 63 years, she oversaw the establishment of more than 100 houses and schools in 12 countries. Her order was approved by Rome in 1826, and she was canonized in 1925.

#### Monitoring your children on YouTube

YouTube is one of the most popular sites for children, and anyone can upload and share videos about anything. YouTube can showcase creativity and foster learning and connection for children, but it is also home to a variety of dangerous and inappropriate content. It is the user's responsibility to filter the content he or she sees, and often, children don't have the ability or knowledge to filter their viewing before it's too late. Talk to your children about what they want to watch, and what they are and are not allowed to do while on YouTube.
